#### Nature of Interest

My parents have a farm in Alstone, GL20 8JD and I own a small parcel of land which forms part of the farm, along with my brother and sister on the edge of Alstone. The land is included in my registration of members interests that is held by Tewkesbury Borough Council

Under RES4 New Housing at Other Rural Settlements in the proposed Preferred Options Consultation Tewkesbury Borough Plan 2011-2031 – Alstone could potentially be classed as one of the 'other rural settlements' under this policy.

The land in question is on the edge of Alstone and amounts to a total of 1 acre, my ownership is 1/3<sup>rd</sup> of this.

RES4 in the proposed consultation covers all rural settlements, except for those located in the green belt, that are not featured within the settlement hierarchy within the draft plan. I believe, therefore that there are approximately 50 rural settlements throughout the borough where RES4 could possibly apply. My parcel of 1/3<sup>rd</sup> of an acre therefore represents a very tiny part of the total amount of land throughout the borough in and around rural settlements to which RES4 could apply, and just one policy of a significant plan which proposes substantial housing and employment land allocations in which I have no Code of Conduct interest. Therefore I believe that my interest in this parcel of land does not outweigh my responsibility to represent the interests of my electorate and the Borough as a whole in the Tewkesbury Borough Plan. I therefore respectfully request that dispensation is given to me to speak and vote in respect of the Tewkesbury Borough Plan coming to full council on the 26 September 2018.
