- (1) Application for dispensation must be in writing.
- (2) Dispensation may be granted only if, after having had regard to all relevant circumstances, it is considered that:-
 - (a) without the dispensation the number of persons prohibited from participating in any particular business would be so great a proportion of the body transacting the business as to impede the transaction of the business,
 - (b) without the dispensation the representation of different political groups on the body transacting any particular business would be so upset as to alter the likely outcome of any vote relating to the business,
 - (c) granting the dispensation is in the interests of persons living in the authority's area,
 - (d) it is otherwise appropriate to grant a dispensation.
- (3) A dispensation must specify the period for which it has effect, and the period specified may not exceed four years.
